Motions Passed

We voted unanimously to accept the changes and additions to the Church bylaws.

1. Call to Order Gayle called the meeting to order at 6:35.

2. Opening Prayer

Sara offered prayer asking for God's love to be present at our meeting.

3. Receiving Minutes

a. September 9th Board meeting

The minutes were approved as corrected.

b. September 22nd quarterly Congregational meeting

The minutes were approved as written.

4. Pastors' Report

We are still looking for a music director. As per Allison, "We are waiting for the right person. Filling this position is often difficult."

Jared and Allison are doing the entire work of the Stewardship Committee since a committee was not formed this year.

Gratitude was given to Sara for her work with children and youth. She is leading children's worship once a month as well as taking leadership in the family program we are getting off the ground. Over 30 attended the first family gathering.

5. Finance Report

We had another positive month. Giving for the month was healthy for the end of the year. For the month we were under budget and above last year's income at this time.

Personnel will have a line item in the budget for the coming year.

Several newer members of the congregation have been giving generously.

6. Old Business

a. Changes to Bylaws

An overview of the changes was presented by Pastor Allison.

New wording assures that the treasurer does not have to do all the functions but will have oversight.

Changes to the bylaws will occur every two years rather than annually. The Board will appoint a task force to receive and review potential changes and create a draft for review and adoption by the Board and congregation.

Youth members will now have the same term limits as members-at-large.

There will be more flexibility as to the number of members on the Personnel Committee. A Personnel Committee member will be added to the Finance Committee.

The names Budget Committee and Finance Committee have been used to identify the same group in the past. We will begin using the name Budget Committee exclusively.

The Property Committee will be working in coordination with the Office Manager. This addition will remind committee members that they are not working alone.

The Stewardship Committee will now be overseeing all church fundraising activities authorized by the Board and will direct the annual financial program of the Church. The committee will meet at least four times during the year.

Kris moved and Charlotte seconded that we accept the proposed changes to the bylaws. The motion was passed unanimously,

The new text of the bylaws will be voted on by members at the next quarterly meeting.

b. Nominating Committee

Graham reported that the Nominating Committee has been moving forward with its work. Many people have been approached and have accepted nominations for positions in the coming year(s).

c. Stewardship

Kris was commended for the quality of her presentation on giving at last Sunday's service. It was suggested that this presentation, which is on video, be used in the future for the stewardship drive.

Commitment Sunday will be on October 27th. There will be a paper pledge card as well as an online pledge form for members to use. The plan is to have the online form available throughout the year.

The proposed budget needs to be to the Board by November 11th.

7. New Business

a. Restructuring of Elder Roles

The Pastors, along with the Elders, are looking to divide the roles of Elders into two groups- worshipping elders and visiting elders. There will be the option of being a part of

both groups. We will continue with having twelve elders.

b. Proposed additions to Personnel Handbook

There was a push back to the proposed additions as well as any of the of the present wording in the handbook that mentions Pastors' children. Paula and Sara will meet to discuss the handbook policy on children of staff members with the goal of bringing this topic and their recommendations back to the Board by the end of the year.

8. Action Items from tonight's meeting

The budget will be presented to the board at the November meeting. We will revisit the Personnel Handbook. The bylaws will be updated.

9. Tending to Community Needs (concerns & celebrations in the Congregation) Jan Hagemeister will be coming home from the hospital today. She will be needing more assistance at home.

Our members with memory concerns continue to rise. More members will be needing rides to church in the next months.

10. Closing Prayer

Pastor's Report October 2024:

• Worship:

- October will conclude our stewardship theme "Festival of Faithfulness" where we'll be exploring labor, harvest, and feast through the lens of parables. November's sermon series is titled "Songs we Sing to God" where preachers will pick a favorite Psalm. Laura Isaac will preach 11/24 when we're out of town for my brother's wedding. December will begin Advent. It's also when we hop back onto the lectionary. Based on lectionary scriptures, our theme will be "Good Tidings of Comfort and Joy." Some lectionary cycles are pretty "doom and gloom" and it was refreshing to study these scriptures and find that's not the case for this year.
- We're continuing to work on inviting folks into worship leadership who aren't the kind of folks to sign up themselves but are happy to do it if asked.

Pastoral Care:

• We've been made aware of several acute pastoral care concerns and have been working diligently to check in with folks. Jared also continues to visit with folks who consider this congregation home but are unable to attend worship or other programming regularly.

Administration:

• Allison continues to work with various committees to facilitate and maintain church processes. She's working with the Budget committee to determine the budget for next year. Nominating is continuing its work—many thanks to that team! We're grateful for folks who have already said yes and for the folks who will say yes over the next few weeks.

• Education:

- Attendance for our 9 am programming continues to be small in number but large in participation and meaning making. The Cornerstone Class continues its study on the Bible through the use of a video series called "Animate." They will be doing a group Lectio Divina on 11/17 and 11/24 (following the conclusion of the study on 11/3 and an Israel-Palestine discernment conversation on 11/10) and have an Advent study beginning on 12/1.
- We had over thirty attend our inaugural family programming conversation. Our next one will be on 10/20 throughout the building.
- Resolution Discernment conversations continue. Based on the three initial conversations, executive team and program cabinet will determine if there is consensus either to 1.) hold a vote and determine possible dates 2.) continue conversations with the possibility for a future vote in 2025 3.) determine that is is not something to vote on. If a vote is to happen, will most likely be in the first quarter of 2025 in order to give enough time and conversation for this topic.

• Ministries:

- The preschool is back in session. 56 families are enrolled. Mondays and Wednesdays are particularly busy with our two 4 year old classes having 16 and 18 kiddos in them.
- Rally Day was well represented. While there weren't a ton of folks signing up, it is an important function to make sure newer folks are able to plug in and get involved with ongoing ministries and groups.

- Pg. 2 Most expenses in line for month. No insurance premium due this. For month Total Expenses are under Budget & Last Year. Lower expenses and good giving resulted in another positive month of \$1,958.26. This also brought the YTD total up to a positive \$2,278.90.
- Pg. 5 Reserved Funds for Staff Gifts went into negative.
- Pg. 7 Once again total Income YTD is highest for 5 year period by a lot! Only year with fewer expenses was 2022 when there were reduced personnel costs. YTD financial position best except for 2020.
 - 2020 was a year of reduced staffing.

Program Cabinet

In other Program Cabinet news:

• The process of discernment continues on whether FCC will affirm the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) 2023 General Assembly Resolution 2339 concerning Israel and Palestine, and the March 20, 2024, pastoral letter on Gaza. A discernment meeting led by Pastor Jared Ruari was held Oct. 7 on Zoom. Eight people, including Jared, attended. Two other discernment meetings are scheduled: after church Sunday, Oct. 20, led by Mike Mayers in Fellowship Hall; and at 9 a.m. Sunday, Nov. 10, in Fellowship Hall, led by Stacey Bartholomew. After the worship service Oct. 6, more than 30 people heard two Israeli speakers — one Jewish, the other from a Palestinian family — share their perspectives on present-day Israel, where both lived until relatively recently. The talk was hosted by the Israel-Palestine Advocacy Team.

PROPOSED ADDITIONS TO PERSONNEL HANDBOOK

SICK LEAVE FOR PASTORAL STAFF, p. 5

Pastors will be allocated up to 10 days off in a calendar year to be used for illness of self or family member. Sick days cannot accumulate from year to year. In the event of extended illness, two weeks or more, sick leave (paid or unpaid) would be negotiated with the Church Co-Chairs, Personnel Committee, and the Church Board. In the case of co-parenting co-pastors, one parent may on occasion choose to work from home in lieu of taking sick leave to care for a child/children.

CHILDREN OF STAFF MEMBERS, p. 9

It is expected that children of staff members will not be at the church during staff work hours. Occasionally, circumstances may arise where an exception to this is needed. With the approval of the employee's supervisor exceptions can be made assuming the child is not disruptive. If a Pastor has a child, the Co-Chairs of the Executive Team in consultation with the Personnel Committee will make this determination. Should a pastor bring a child/children to the office, the pastor will keep the child/ children in their office with the door closed. Pastors will not bring their children to work if they are showing visible signs of being sick, if they have thrown up within the previous 24 hours, or if they are contagious.
