Guidelines for Mission Grants

Funds are available to support members of the congregation who are interested in supporting or participating in a mission project or agency, to provide a one-time grant for an ongoing mission project, or to help develop a mission project.

GUIDELINES

1. The money will be used for a mission project outside of the church's budgeted/funded line items, with the exception that items listed under Outreach in the budget may be considered.
2. Priorities will be given to (but not limited to) the following types of projects:
 - Those with tangible, concrete benefits that improve quality of life and/or increase self-sufficiency.
 - Those for education and/or training that have the potential to improve the ability to be self-sustaining and/or to increase resources.
 - Those that enable our members to actively participate with the agency or the beneficiaries of the project.
3. Proposals need to be submitted to the Mission Committee on an application form by January 31st or July 31st. Exceptions to this timeline may be made at the discretion of the Mission Committee.
4. A simple majority vote of all members of the Mission Committee will make decisions.
5. Any amount in excess of \$10,000 at the end of the year shall be distributed in January to FCC non-budgeted missions by the Mission Grant Committee. The amount going to each mission is to be determined at the discretion of the Mission Grant Committee.
